1. Program Objective:

Provide financial support to trumpet players with economic needs, with a particular focus on residents of Latin America, to help them improve their skills and achieve their academic and professional goals.

2. Eligibility:

- Individuals with demonstrable financial needs.
- Preference for residents of Latin America, though not exclusive.
- Commitment to participate in four group classes per month.

3. Scholarship Coverage:

- Scholarships covering up to 70% of the cost of Your Trumpet Studio programs.
- The exact percentage of the scholarship will be determined based on the individual needs of the applicant.

4. Application Process:

- Send an email to info@yourtrumpetstudio.com.
- Include a motivation letter explaining the need for the scholarship and how it will help achieve your goals.
 - Attach a CV in PDF format (optional).
 - Live recording.

5. Evaluation and Selection:

- Applications will be evaluated on an individual basis.
- The applicant's financial situation and potential benefit from the program will be considered.
 - Preference will be given to residents of Latin America, though it is not exclusive.

6. Scholarship Recipient Commitments:

- Participate in four group classes per month.
- Transcribe two classes per month.
- Actively engage in the program and make the most of the resources provided.

7. Application Deadline:

- Scholarships will be awarded on a rolling basis until all five available scholarships are granted.
